College Rules and Regulations

- 1. A Student of H.S. Classes must attend atleast 75% of the total classes held during the session and for a degree student 95% attendance is compulsory.
- 2. Wearing uniform is compulsory for students except on Thursday.
- 3. Students are strictly prohibited from leaving the college campus during the college hour.
- 4. Principal's decision in matters relating to maintenance of disciplines will be binding.
- 5. Any form of ragging is strictly prohibited. Such activities will be dealt with strictly.
- 6. The student should reach at College premises before 10-30 a.m. positively because the College gate will remain closed at that time.
- 7. Any students violating the rules of the College may be suspended from the College.
- 8. In case of any breakages of College property by students will be regarded an offence and student will be Rave to bear the cost of the particular item.
- 9. Every students should posses Identity Card with her photo affix on it duly attested by the Principal.
- 10. Students are strickly forbiden from participating in Political agitations of any kind.
- 11. Jeans Pants and Leggings or Churidar are strickly prohibited. Violation of Dress Code may result in Punishments as deemed fit.

Examination and Its Rules (Only for TDC Course):

There shall be atleast one sessional exam in each semester.

1. More weightage is given to internal assessment/evaulation

Internal assessment/evaluation = 20% External evaluation = 80%









Internal Assessment:

- a) Sessional or mid-term examination will be conducted for 50% of the total marks allotted for Internal Assessment of a course/paper. (For example, if 20 marks is allotted for Internal Assessment of a course/paper, then 10 marks will be kept aside for assessment in sessional or mid-term examination. The sessional examination will be held for 30 marks for the convenience of setting questions and covering the syllabus and the marks secured by the students will be proportionately converted to be out of 10 marks.
- b) 20% of the marks allotted for Internal Assessment will be awarded to the students based on class attendance. If the total marks for Internal Assessment is 20, then 4 marks will be awarded to the students based on class attendance. The following criteria will be adopted for awarding marks under this category:
- a) Class attendance from 76% to 80% 1 mark;
- b) Class attendance from 81% to 85% 2 marks;
- c) Class attendance from 86% to 90%. 3 marks;
- d) Class attendance from 91% and above......4 marks.
- c) Rest 30% of the marks allotted for Internal Assessment will be distributed and awarded on the basis of performance of the students on the following criteria:
- a) Home assignments;
- b) Seminar/Group discussions;
- c) Field work;
- d) Performance in co-curricular and extracurricular activities.









IDENTITY CARD:

Every Bonafide students will be issued college Identity Card at the time of Admission.
